

InTech Collegiate High School Graduation Requirements

InTech Collegiate awards high school diplomas to students who successfully complete 26 total high school credits in specified content areas as shown below (credit requirements vary by graduating year).

1 year of AP course work or a score of 3 or better on an AP exam will equal 1.0 high school credits. Three college credits is equal to .5 high school credits.

** For transfer students, only 1 credit of the Additional InTech Collegiate Requirements is required for each year of attendance at InTech Collegiate.

Modifications to Graduation Requirements

Per R277-700-7J, state graduation requirements may be modified for individual students when the modifications:

- 1) Are consistent with the student's IEP or SEOP
- 2) Are maintained in the student file and include a parent/guardian signature
- 3) Maintain the integrity and rigor expected for high school graduation

As a standing modification to the state core curriculum and in keeping with requirements to offer alternatives for demonstrating competency in the core curriculum (R277-705-3), the InTech Board approves the following courses as substitutions:

HIST 1700 American Civilizations (college course) may substitute for US History II (core curriculum course)
