## Spring Semester 2007

At the Parent-Student Meeting on December 12th, InTech staff presented some new information that will be in effect this semester, including our new schedule, new lunch caterers, and our graduation requirements. For those of you who were not able to attend, we have summarized that information for you:

We have changed our bell schedule. It will be as follows:

(Monday-Wednesday)

Fifth Period	1:40-2:32

Students, please note that passing time between classes has been shortened to 3 minutes and adjust accordingly.

On Thursdays and Fridays class periods will be shorter. (We will still end at 2:25 on Fridays, and we have changed our Career Exploration presentations to Thursday afternoons).

Graduation requirements are posted on our website. Parents, please look over the requirements and make sure that your students are taking the additional classes they will need to graduate. Classes can be taken online through the electronic high school (<http://ehs.uen.org>), while other classes are offered after school. ## Mentoring

On December 1, Dr. Alok Bhushan, a professor in the College of Pharmacy at Idaho State University, presented to our students. Dr. Bhushan's research interests involve cancer and chemotherapy, and he discussed with students ways to prevent, recognize, and treat cancer. He also emphasized the importance of not smoking as one of the most effective ways to prevent lung cancer.

On December 8th, Deborah Gardner, co-founder of the non-profit organization One Heart Bulgaria, presented to our students about the living conditions of orphans in Bulgaria. She illustrated that people living in America have so much compared to the orphans in Bulgaria.

She committed our school to raising \$1000 to benefit the Bulgarian orphanages. This money will be used to replace the broken windows in the orphanage to protect the children from the bitter winter weather.
