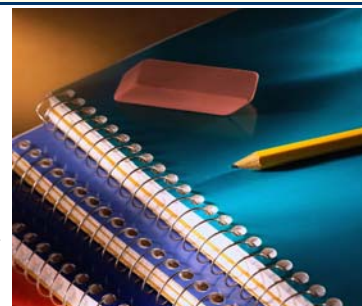
## Back to School/Registration Day

Every student will need to attend their designated day for registration.

**Incoming Freshmen Students** will attend Back to School Day on Tuesday, August 21, from 9 AM to 8:30 PM. Students will pay fees (expect to pay \$150 of fees; yearbooks may also be paid for at this time for \$30), get their pictures taken (come in school uniform!), get lockers, turn in their signed permission slips for the ropes course, and take a math assessment to determine which math class they will be in. Once their students fees are paid, students will be given a collared shirt with the InTech logo. In addition to fulfilling

these requirements, a fun program is also planned for Back to School Day. Students will attend a short presentation on dress code, meet their new teachers, become acquainted with the different extra-curricular organizations at InTech, and get to know one another better through participating in activities at the USU Ropes Course.

**All Other Students** will need to attend Registration Day on Wednesday, August 22, anytime during 10 AM - 1 PM. Students will pay fees (please expect to pay \$150 of fees; yearbooks may also be paid for at this time for \$30), get their pictures taken (come in school uniform!), and be assigned lockers.



Students who attended InTech last year will get their class schedules; new students who are not freshmen will need to take a math assessment on Registration Day to determine which math class they will be placed in. New students will be given a collared shirt with the InTech logo on it when they pay their fees.

# Student Fees

InTech strives to provide quality education for students at the lowest possible cost in student fees. Student fees must be paid before the first day of school; freshmen students will pay at Back to School Day and all other students will pay on Registration Day.
