- Mentoring. Students went on a field trip or had a presenter come speak with them most every week during the school year.

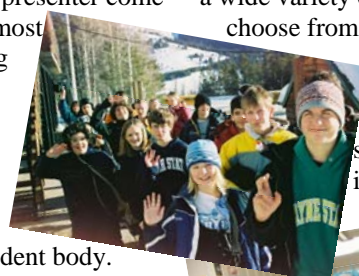
- Dances! The Student Council hosted numerous dances with fun themes for the student body.
